## Conference Fees

For those attending in-person, registration is \$135 for both days through September 30 (\$145 thereafter), \$70 for either Friday or Saturday's session through September 30 (\$80 thereafter). Online attendance for both days is \$30; field trips are not available online.

*Registration includes a Welcome Reception with light hors d'oeuvres, followed by a plated dinner on Friday, and breakfast and lunch buffets on Saturday.*

*Explore the greater Sheboygan area! You will have the option to attend a field trip of your choice on Friday afternoon. Trip details for various options will be provided to registrants closer to the event.*

Attendees will provide their own transportation to the field trip destination; there will not be buses. The tours will not be available via Zoom.

## Accommodations

Attendees may stay at Blue Harbor Resort, 725 Blue Harbor Drive, Sheboygan, WI at a **discounted rate of \$149 per night**. The **discounted room block of 30 rooms is available until September 23**. Once sold out or after September 23, the discounted room rate will only be

extended based on availability. Due to limited space, we recommend making your reservation as soon as possible. This reservation is separate from the Annual Meeting and Conference Registration.

If you plan on staying two nights and would like the discounted rate for both nights, you must reserve by telephone. Second night stay, at discounted rate, is subject to availability.
